"How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of Him that bringeth good tidings, that publisheth peace; that bringeth good tidings of good, that publisheth salvation; that saith unto Zion, Thy God reigneth!" Isaiah 52:7

The message of the Kingdom brings good news. God is raising up in our day a corporate son, a many membered body of which Jesus Christ is the head. In this beautiful verse "How upon mountains are the feet of Him" the Him here, is singular and masculine. The prophet Isaiah is pointing to the soon coming Jesus, the Son of God. In contrast, Paul says it this way in Romans 10:15, "...How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace..." The Him in the Old Testament has become a them in the New Testament. You cannot separate the Head from the body. The Apostle Paul used the analogy of the body of Christ in order to give us a revelatory understanding of how the body functions. Jesus is the head, and

the head is what governs the body. As the head goes so goes the body, what we think in our minds determines the function of the body.

You are a part of the corporate Christ. In this scripture the Holy Spirit, through Apostle Paul, is letting the church know that through the body of Christ Jesus will be revealed in the earth. His glory, His power and His beauty will be seen in His feet! The feet are the part of the body that is in contact with the earth. We, being Christ's body will be part of what He is about to do in the earth.

The Apostle Paul talks about the whole family of God both in heaven, and on the earth. We are not separated from those who have gone before us to heaven, but instead, we are connected to them in spirit because we are one. Our family in heaven, without us, cannot be made perfect. They do not have their glorified bodies yet so they are waiting for us to finish the race. This mighty cloud of witnesses are cheering us on as the people in the earth who will walk out the word of God, and who will become the Foot Company, bringing all enemies under our feet. Those who have gone on before us are not the feet. They are still a part of Christ's body but they are not the Foot Company. We, who are in contact with the earth now, are the Foot Company and we bring heaven and earth together. We are the people who have come to the end of this age. We have not come to the end of the world, as it has been said many times, but we have come to the end of the age. Throughout the New Testament the word world was not translated correctly. In the Greek, the term world reads, the end of an age or an era. We are at the end of the grace age and are coming into the Kingdom of God. We are the people whom God has chosen to be in the planet at the end of this age, and as "the feet" we are anointed with the very same anointing that is on our head, Jesus.

Just as the High Priest on the Day of Atonement would move from the outer court of the tabernacle into the Most Holy Place, so the Foot Company is now

beginning to move. While the priest ministered in the Most Holy Place, there were three parts of his body that were exposed, his head, his hands and his feet. The rest of his body was covered with three layers of garments. The head was symbolic of the revealing of Jesus that took place 2000 years ago. His hands represented the Fivefold ministry. Jesus, at the end of this age, has been restoring the hand of God: Apostles, Prophets, Pastors and Evangelists, Teachers. What are yet to

be exposed are the feet; or the Body of Christ, the saints of God in the earth. When the priest was standing at the altar of incense, his robes would flow to the ground concealing his feet. Only when he began to walk, were the feet of the priest unveiled. The body of Christ is beginning to move in this hour revealing

the feet. God cannot manifest himself through the Foot Company until we walk in truth. The reason the church has concealed God's power is because they have not walked in truth.

"I have refrained my feet from every evil way, that I might keep thy word." Psalms 119:101

As the Foot Company we must walk in "the way". The Way is a person, Jesus, and to know His ways you must be related to, and be intimate with Him. Jesus said, "I Am the Way the Truth and the Life", therefore; you must have a relationship with Him if you are going to know His way, His truth and His life. You

cannot walk in truth or life until you meet The Way.

"Behold my hands and my feet that it is I myself; handle me, and see; for a spirit hath not flesh and bones, as ye see me have." Luke 24:39, 40

Jesus appeared to His disciples on the third day after His resurrection. When He revealed Himself to them He did not show them the scars on His

forehead from the crown of thorns, but He showed them His hands and His feet. As we are stepping into this third day in God, He is beginning to manifest His resurrection power to the world through His hands (the five-fold ministry) and His Feet (the Body of Christ).



"And behold I will make the place of My feet glorious." Isaiah 60:13b

We have a promise that all the glory of heaven will be manifested in the earth through the Foot Company. The glory of the Lord will be seen, and it will cover the earth as the waters cover the sea. The Foot Company will express and manifest the very nature and ministry of Jesus Christ. His nature speaks of the fruits of the Spirit; His love, His joy, and His peace. The ministry of Christ speaks of the gifts of the spirit; signs, wonders and creative miracles. We are promised in this verse that the feet of Christ will be glorious, and that He will have a glorious church giving full expression of our Lord and Savior in the earth.

"Thy Word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path." Psalm 119:105



Why is the Word a lamp unto our feet and not unto our eyes? Because it is not what you see or what you say, but it is what you do. The power is in your walk. Jesus

said in Luke 10:19, "Behold, I give you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you." Jesus did not say you will speak to serpents and scorpions, He said you will tread upon serpents and scorpions. There are a lot of people who are talking, but if they do not walk it

out, there is no power in their talk. Remember, the power is in your walk!

"The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou at my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool." Psalm 110:1

The Father said to His Son, "Sit at My right hand until all of your enemies have been made your footstool". Some of those enemies are poverty, sickness, disease, fear, doubt and so on. This is a promise that all of these enemies will come under the feet of Jesus Christ, and we are the feet!

God tells Jesus to sit at His right hand until.... This means Jesus cannot come back at "any minute" as many have said. That is not in the scripture. scripture says until all of our enemies are made Christ's footstool. We are here to occupy until He comes. There are a people in the earth today who are bearing the incorruptible, indestructible seed of Jesus Christ, who will be the glorious and victorious church! They will bring every enemy, cancer, diabetes, hatred, drug demons, poverty, sickness and even death under their feet! Nothing can stand before the Foot Company that God is raising up in this day!

This next level of glory is not a goose bump or a feeling, but one of character and behavior. It is beyond just a revival for revival is only a visitation of God. While we thank God for every visitation we have experienced in the body of Christ, we must understand and recognize that we are moving into a habitation. Habitation is an indwelling, where God takes up residence within His people and manifests Himself through His

body, the Foot Company. That is why it is so imperative for us become people of Godly character and integrity, which is demonstrated through our behavior.

"And his feet like unto fine brass, as if they burned in a furnace; and his voice as the sound of many waters."

Revelation 1:15

"Behold, I have refined thee, but not with silver; I have chosen thee in the furnace of affliction."

Isaiah 48:10



God calls us out of the world but He chooses us in the furnace; "many are called but few are chosen". So if you are in the fire, God chose you to be there. Don't whine and beg God for an easier way for this is the

election of God. He is proving you so that He might choose you to carry and demonstrate His glory. He sent His fire so you can qualify to be a part of the Foot Company. Think about it, you could have been born at any time in the last 2000 years, but God chose you for this time. So what do you do when you are in the fire? Isaiah says to sing and rejoice in the fire. I know it is hard to do at times, but that is what we are instructed to do. God is bringing about a refining in your life. As a part of this Foot Company you will be as fine brass when God is finished refining you, and you will reflect Him, emulate Him and radiate Him wherever you go. People will see Him in you.

Our text in Revelation 1:15 reads, "And His feet were like unto fine brass." Christ's feet are standing in a fire and they are as fine brass. The word fine here means, "to be polished". Have you been feeling like you have been rubbed the wrong way? God places people and situations in our lives to rub us the right way. He has been putting pressure on you because He is shining your feet. He is shining the Foot Company so His image will be seen in them.

There are a people who are in the earth right now, who have been standing in the furnace of affliction. God is allowing this affliction, or fire, to produce His image in them. Therefore, you have been going through afflictions and hardships because God is refining you so that you can walk as Jesus walked, heal as Jesus healed, deliver as He delivered and speak with the same authority that Jesus spoke in. The fourth Man is appearing in the midst of your fire.

"I was glad when they said unto me, Let us go into the house of the LORD. Our feet shall stand within thy gates, O Jerusalem." Psalm 122:1& 2

Gates speak of praise. Isaiah says, "His gates shall be called praise. I will stand in praise." At the end of this age there shall be a people who will enter a dimension of praise higher than any man has ever known, and the Lord's Foot Company will stand in praise. As the Foot Company we are bringing heaven and earth together, because through our praise and worship we create an atmosphere of heaven here on earth, in which God inhabits. What you have been through has caused you to become a real worshiper. It has made you a priest and

has given you access into God's presence. For this time, God has chosen you. He has placed His incorruptible Seed in you, Jesus. That today men may know "...How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things!"
